Welcome by Alan Bell, WMA Vice President Competition:

Remarkable point of information: for the first time in history of WMAC(i) an athlete from Mongolia (M85) was World Champion. It's a global message.

Please inform your athletes they are NOT allowed to use their phones during the competition. They have to leave their phones in their bag. According to WA rules, an athlete will get a yellow card for this.

Sandy Pashkin, WMA Technical Information Manager:

In the results online, sometimes it showed "EXH" behind an athlete's name; that means: yellow card. From now on only 'YC' = (yellow card) will be shown.

USA: does YC means: a yellow card only for the event in which it happened?

Alan: no, a yellow card is for the whole championship. A second yellow card for the same athlete, even in another event, means a red card, so DQ.

Sandy: in the first two days of competition 5 World Records masters and 14 Championships Records masters were set.

Romania: there are spikes that can't be taken off, are they allowed?

Michael Serralta: as long as they are 'pyramid' spikes. Michael will check them.

Slawek Krankowski, WMA Organizational Manager:

There are some empty country information boards (outside the Welcome Center). Can we store them, or will anyone need them? No, most of the countries have WhatsApp groups to inform their athletes.

Next time we'll ask the Team Managers beforehand who will use the boards.

Please inform your athletes about the officials in the waiting areas: they are there for safety reasons and to control the rules. They are there for the benefit of the athletes.
